A Little Lozier History Relavent to
the Lozier House on Goffle Road
at Midland Park, N.J.

Cornelius John Lozier farmed a part of the original "Lozier Farm" at Hackensack, N.J. during his early years. He was a miller by trade and his politics put him square in the middle of the road. He liked the rebels who were of a minority, and he respected the "law and order" of the tory government, but mainly he wanted to sell his grain to whoever had the money. The Lozier family was badly split over the revolutionary political situation. Many of his cousins were ardent patriots, and some of them were loyalists, but Cornelius was able to keep on the good side of both parties which was no simple trick.

Cornelius knew a Mr. Banta who farmed the ground on Goffle Road where the present Lozier House stands. Banta was having trouble with the Torsy trespassing over his farm and taking some of the crops. He told Cornelius that he wished he could get in closer to Hackensack where the Torsy were more careful about their actions. They agreed to trade farms, and a part of the deal was that Banta was to serve two hitches in the Continental Army for David and John Lozier, the teenage sons of Cornelius. The farms were traded and Banta served military time for the boys. Son John Lozier inherited the farm upon the death of his father, Cornelius. The farm consisted of 104 acres at that time, but upon the death of John in 1822, the farm must have been sold off, as the sons of John raised their families in the Sparta and Franklin Lakes areas of New Jersey.

A brother of Cornelius, John Lozier of Hackensack, was what might be called a notorious patriot of the rebel cause. He was a member of the Bergen County Rangers carrying on some rather aggressive guerrilla warfare for the Continental Army. The British had a price on his head and in the Torsy controlled papers of New York City, he was called a murderer, a thief and such. The loyalists sent a detachment into the Hackensack area to apprehend the "villain". He was caught and imprisoned at New York City. General George Washington intervened personally and traded British prisoners he held for the return of John Lozier.

Cornelius had a cousin named Nicholas who was also a miller. He fled to Belleville, Canada via the Mohawk valley with all his possessions to escape service in the Continental Army and as a result his home was confiscated by the Federal government. This Nicholas was a proud Loyalist and he changed the spelling of his name to Lazier and today, many of his descendants carry this Lazier name in Canada. A brother of this Nicholas, Peter Lozier of Schraalenburgh was a patriot who served in the Continental Army. So it was that the Loziers were split and pitted, brother against brother in the revolution.

It is interesting to note that with few exceptions, most Loziers in the U.S. today are descendants of Francols Le Sueur, a civil engineer who came from Normandy, France in 1657. His youngest son, Nicholas took to the spelling

of Lozier as the best his Dutch relatives could teach him in order to handle a French name in the new English language. Another Le Sueur son took the name of Lasher, being the John Lasher of N.Y.C. who was a strong supporter of the revolutionary Government.

At this point something should be said of this first Nicholas Lozier. His father, Francois, died when he was three years old and he was raised by his mother and the Dutch people at Harlem and Kingston, N.Y. Many of these Dutch were to be the wives and mothers of subsequent Loziers. The names of Banta, Demarest, Peck, Ackerman, De Baun, Benson, Blauvelt, Westervelt, Bertholt and many others including the Zabriskies run frequently as spouses of the Loziers. Shortly after Nicholas Lozier married, he purchased a farm at Hackensack from the proprietors of New Jersey, who represented the English Crown. Part of this farm remained in the Lozier family until 1937 without interruption in the chain of title. Upon the death of Nicholas, the farm was broken up by will to the 10 sons. Some of the sons sold their shares back to those who stayed on the land to farm it. The ones who stayed on the land did quite well, sending their children to good schools and eventually off to be doctors, lawyers and successful business men. The Loziers who sold out, mostly went to N.Y.C. and apparently were soon out of their money. Their descendants were most often the laborers, drivers, and workmen in the hub-bub of the large city. It is interesting to note that the family records of those who stayed out of N.Y.C. are much more complete than those who lived in the city.

Some interesting facts of the Loziers are as follows:

Probably the most interesting of all was Henry Abram Lozier, the manufacturer of the Lozier car and the Cleveland bicycle. He descends from a brother of Cornelius John Lozier; Abraham Lozier of Walldwick and Paramus, N.J.

William S. Lozier, founder of the large firm at Rochester, N.Y., Lozier Engineers, who do a great deal of municipal engineering, descended from Petrus Lozier, the third son of Nicholas. In his lineage is an Abraham Lozier, sergeant in the Continental Army.

Dr. Abraham Witten Lozier and his wife Dr. Clemence S. Lozier founded the New York Medical College and Hospital for Women. Their son, Dr. Abraham, Jr. also carried on the family profession. The senior Dr. was born and raised at the Lozier House on Goffle Road.

The great Lozier Ranch at Cora, Wyoming which has been in the same family since the early days of the old west was founded by Levi Lozier after leaving New Jersey in the mid 1800s. His father, Peter A. Lozier of Edgewater, N.J. had the largest Lozier family known of to date, 22 children in all. Peter A. Lozier descends from the second son of Nicholas, Hildebrand Lozier. The writer also descends from this Peter A. Lozier.

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My information has been gathered from many different sources with a strong emphasis on family records from all parts of the country. It has been my desire to correspond with every living Lozier in order to get additional information and to update, correct, and corroborate other sources of data. By necessity much judgment has had to go into compiling all the various facts, but I believe my work to be the most complete and accurate pool of Lozier history available. It is constantly being added to and corrected as new information is received.

MIDLAND PARK—The Lozier

House at Paterson Avenue and

Goffle Road, squat but sturdy,

was built to last.

The split-level sandstone

house, located on land which

was once farmland but is now

the center of the borough's busi-

ness district, is the oldest home

in the Dutch community. It was

built prior to the Revolutionary

War.

Cornelius Lozier of Norman

descent moved to the area from

Hackensack and built a mill on

the Wacaraw Stream.

Because he operated a grist-

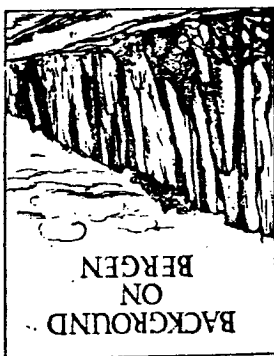
mill, his home was the center of

activity as other settlers came

to him for flour.

The house, in which wooden

pegs were used in place of mill



Mills. It was owned by Garrett A. Lydecker, and then purchased by Abraham Van Riper who built a mill north of the house in 1826. Bought by Wortendyke This mill, which still stands, later purchased by John and Isaac Wortendyke, major contributors to the development of Midland Park. Today the house is occupied by two families, and the mill is owned by the Wostbrock family which transformed the original grist and lampwick factory into an embroidery and water treatment center. In times of blackout, the mill is still prepared to make use of the water power—although with a turbine rather than a water engine.

This biographical sketch of Dr. Clemence S. Lozier is typical of many to be found on her work in the various encyclopedias. Her husband, Abraham Whitten Lozier, is listed as a carpenter in the New York City directories from 1830 to 1837. He was born in the "LOZIER HOUSE", a historical site at Midland Park, New Jersey, protected from "progress" by the government. This house is a pre-revolutionary home built by Cornelius John Lozier, the great

grandson of Francois Le Sueur, the French Huguenot and progenitor of the Lozier clan.

This article mentions only the first wife

of Dr. Abraham W. Lozier, Dr., Charlotte

Irene. It fails to point out that his sec-

ond wife, Dr. Jeanne (de la Montagne) Lozier

was also a practicing physician in New York

City and is listed in the directories of that

city from 1879 to 1886. Dr. Abraham W. Lozier

is listed in the city directories from 1859

to 1894 as a physician. A daughter by the first

wife, Jessica Charlotte (Lozier) Payne was a

well known lecturer in New York City during

her time. Her lectures, like her grandmother's,

were to encourage women to excel in their chosen

fields and to enter professional areas dominated

by men.

LOZIER, Clemence Sophia, physician, b. in Plainfield, N. J., 11 Dec., 1812; d. in New York city, 20 April, 1888. She was the youngest daughter of David Harned, and in 1828 married Abraham W. Lozier, of New York, but soon afterward, her husband's health failing, she opened a select school and taught for eleven years. During this time she was associated with Mrs. Margaret Fry or in visiting the poor and abandoned, under the auspices of the Moral reform society. After her husband's death she determined to study medicine, attended her first lectures at Rochester eclectic medical college in 1849, and was graduated at the Syracuse medical college in 1853. Dr. Lozier at once began practice as a homoeopathist in New York, where she continued to reside, and in the surgery required by the diseases of her own sex displayed peculiar skill, performing many capital operations in the removal of tumors. In 1860 she began a course of lectures on medical subjects in her own parlors, which in 1863 resulted in the founding of the New York medical college and hospital for women, where she was clinical professor of diseases of women and children, and also dean of the faculty, for more than twenty years. This institution was the first exclusively woman's medical college to be established in New York state. Dr. Lozier took an active interest in all that pertains to the elevation of her sex, for thirteen years was president of the New York city woman suffrage society, and for four years of the National woman suffrage society. She also held office in other philanthropic and reform associations, and was an occasional contributor to medical journals.—Her daughter-in-law, Charlotte Irene, physician, b. in Milburn, N. J., 15 March, 1844; d. in New York city, 3 Jan., 1870, was the daughter of Jacob S. Donnan, and was graduated in 1867 at the New York medical college and hospital for women. In 1868 she was called to fill the chair of physiology and hygiene in that institution, which relation she held until her death. Dr. Lozier took an active part in the struggle to secure for female students the privilege of attending the clinics of Bellevue hospital, leading them herself to the wards and operating-rooms. She was an able lecturer, an original investigator in anatomy and physiology, a skillful practitioner, and an energetic worker in all movements for the elevation of her sex. In 1866 she married Dr. Abraham W. Lozier, son of Dr. Clemence S. Lozier.
